The previous collaborative meeting minutes were not included in the meeting packet.

The past or ongoing Initiatives were discussed:

- General
 - Board Nominations: Need nominations from the collaborative body. Currently have three nominations and will review all nominations at the end of May.
 - DFC Application: The Drug Free Communities grant is a federal grant through SAMSA. This as a way to continue our prevention services as our APP grant is ending this year. Allowed to pick two substances with this contract, agreed on alcohol and tobacco as target substances.
 - Future Speakers: Collaborative decided presentations longer than 10 minutes should happen after the regular meeting has been adjourned.
- Alcohol Prevention Project:
 - Still looking for an alcohol prevention project coordinator. Job is on the Camden Chamber of Commerce website.
 - Compliancy Checks: Working with Sheriff's department. Will have 4 compliancy checks done by the end of September.
 - Social Norming Campaign: CCAT is leading peer identified role models
- Focus Areas: Child Abuse & Neglect:
 - Child Abuse Protocol: Decided last collaborative meeting to make LIPT our child abuse focus team. Our child abuse protocol has remained un-updated since 2012. Collaborative voted to make the update a collaborative focus strategy.

Upcoming and Other Initiatives:

- Data Walk: Postponed due to planning and scheduling conflicts with us and the evaluator..

- Teen Maze: Teen Maze will take place on April 26th. Express Scripts has committed to being a business sponsor and will give us needed people to assist. This teen maze we are looking at renting wall dividers to make it look more like an actual maze.
- Youth Summit: Will take place on a weekday evening from 5:30-7:30. Open for middle and high schoolers. Looking at changing date from May 3rd due to the final exams at CCGA. Looking for a new location. The Auditorium at Camden County High School is a proposed location. May be possible to use collaborative funds to rent the venue.

- Woodbine Super Saturday: Benefit program for the Woodbine Park program and the military program. Anyone can set up a booth and sell anything, give anything, or give info along the woodbine river walk. Tables and chairs will be provided for a small fee. It will be held on May 21st from 8am-5pm
