The Meeting was brought to order at 10:05 am.

The previous collaborative meeting minutes were distributed and reviewed.

The group briefly discussed the Child Abuse Neglect Prevention Initiative grant along with the Mental Health Domestic Violence and SMUMCF FINS incentives for LIPT/CHINS/Attendance Panel review. Child Abuse Neglect Prevention Initiative has been submitted to GOCF. Mental Health/Domestic Violence funded by Verizon, need to collect at least 400 surveys from 9 counties. SMUMCF parents are to complete case plans, they can receive incentives of up to \$650. Not approved yet but have received MOA's.

The past or ongoing Initiatives were discussed:

- School Supply Drive – August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 430 backpacks were distributed, remaining 65 were donated
- Alcohol Prevention Initiative – CCAT: Working with 6 students and CCGA to make campaign using high school class as test group; DEFY 2: Trying to implement into middle schools; Compliance: Trying to get On Premise; SS: Finished, printing, will be distributed soon.
- Financial Management Series: Aug 26<sup>th</sup> is 4<sup>th</sup> class out of the 5 class series. It will be on credit and it is in conjunction with CCAR, Habitat, and United 1<sup>st</sup>. Having great response out of the classes.
- Juvenile Reinvestment – Having conference this week. Have 12 juveniles eligible every year for diversion program.
- Liza Rudolf Trail – Tough to get responses, improved trail, there are 2 comfort stations and are working on getting fitness stations
- Community Service Center – Building Hopefully by the EOY
- Midtown Park – Redevelopment plan for Cumberland Oaks, new city manager meeting week after next, the previous city manager was encouraging and identified 5 different possible areas for the park.

- McKinney Community Health Center – Opening next to CASA possibly by the end of the year. Possibly waiting for funding.

Upcoming and Other Initiatives:

- YELP – September 9<sup>th</sup> 5:30 – 7:30. Classroom 107 at CCGA. Applications at the high school. Looking for adult volunteers.
- Suicide Prevention Conference – At CCGA all day. Participants funded for 2 nights. 26 coalitions are sending representatives. Can register online. Lodging information and activities on web page

- Depression screening – October, flier coming soon. As always it is free. Will be at CCGA Rotunda 5-7pm, information will be in the newspaper
