The Meeting was brought to order at 10:03 am.

The previous collaborative meeting minutes were distributed and reviewed.

The group briefly discussed the Child Abuse Neglect Prevention Initiative grant along with the Mental Health Domestic Violence and SMUMCF FINS incentives for LIPT/CHINS/Attendance Panel review. Participant incentives can be up to \$650. The Child Abuse Neglect Prevention Initiative grant has already been submitted. Also briefly discussed was the Juvenile Reinvestment grant which was approved for continuation but not yet approved for expansion.

The past or ongoing Initiatives were discussed:

- McKinney Community Health Center – Can see a doctor for as little as \$10 and as much as \$30
- Suicide Prevention – Approved for \$4000
- Alcohol Prevention Initiative – Working on tailgate: August 23rd, Compliancy Checks were done and those that didn't sell got certificates from the CCAT kids, Seller Server Training being completed
- Liza Rudolf Trail – No official update yet, agreed to do everything at one set price.
- Midtown Park – Coming up with redevelopment plan to improve Cumberland oaks
- Mobile Crisis Services – Services have been started, there have been a decrease of ER visits this month
- Community Day Fundraiser – To raise money for United Way. Needed local businesses to participate. Serving food and showing an outdoor movie afterward
- United Way is offering office space to Non-Profits

Upcoming and Other Initiatives:

- School Supply Drive – Walgreens very helpful in donations, Walmart Gave \$1000 grant, receiving help from churches. Need volunteers August 1st-2nd. Need backpacks and 3-ring binders
- Middle School Afterschool programs – Want to have a once a week after school program that covers DEFY, Leadership, and Sources of strength training

- Teen Maze – Pencil Date October 28th
- Depression screening – Will still be in October
- Holding woman's self-defense training in Waycross.
